



Artist Application and Guidelines

The Deco Mercado Days is a new initiative between Centro Cultural Aztlan and the Jefferson/Woodlawn Lake Community Development Corp to offer a wide range of affordable fresh produce from nearby farmers and other homemade products to our community and consumers. In addition, flowers and bedding plants and other unique vendors (artisans, designers, and makers of specialty items) will all help make Deco Mercado Days a fun place to shop and socialize every third Saturday of the Month.

The Deco Mercado Days will be held on the premises (Deco Building facility and parking lot) where Centro Cultural Aztlan is located at 1800 Fredericksburg Road. This location is perfect as we are surrounded by seven active neighborhood associations and a thriving artists' community.

GUIDELINES:

- Spaces are approximately 10' x 10'.
- You are responsible for your own canopy (white top preferred), tables, chairs, and displays.
- All display materials, labels and signs must be kept within the confines of your booth space.
- All extra inventory and stock must be contained within your space. All extra inventory and boxes must be covered or under tables.
- You must maintain your booth and surroundings clean and must not infringe on another artist/vendor space.
- All money is collected by the seller. You are responsible to bring enough change for the day. You are allowed to have credit card transactions, WIFI is available. You will be solely responsible to report any sales taxes collected.
- There are no cancellations or refunds.
- All Art and Fine Crafts must be handmade and the original work of the artist applying. Arts and Crafts not created by the exhibitor or not in the category applied for will not be permitted in the show. Resale of wholesale items IS NOT permitted.

FEES:

Artist and Crafters: \$30 per day.

DATES AND SET UP TIMES:

The Market reoccurs every third Saturday from 9AM - 2PM through December.

The dates are as followed:

June 20, July 18, August 15, September 19, October 17, November 21, and December 19.

Set Up Times are from 7:00AM - 8:30AM. You must be set up by 9AM.
